LOCAL LEAGUE REGIONAL SILVER STICK

The HSMHA is very pleased to be hosting our 14th Silver Stick Regional for Local League / House League teams for Atom, Peewee, Bantam & Midget. Each age group will be 8 team tourneys running 2 divisions of four teams. Teams will play a 3 game, round robin point series on the Saturday at either the S.G. Nesbitt Arena in Minden or the A.J. LaRue Arena in Haliburton. The top two teams in each division will advance to the semi-finals on Sunday morning at the designated arena for that tournament. Every player and member of each coaching staff will receive a Silver Stick pin for participating. Semi-finalists will receive individual awards and the finalists will receive individual awards plus a team banner. The champions will receive individual awards plus a team banner (3 ft x 4 ft). The championship team will represent our district at the international tournament of champions for the Silver Stick. The Silver Stick Entry Fee for Atom and Peewee AE teams is \$835.00 and for Bantam & Midget AE teams is \$875.00 GATE INCLUDED. Guaranteed 3 games, could play 5. All spectators are free. Teams MUST have approved rosters to participate.

REP TEAMS "FALL CLASSIC" TOURNAMENTS

The HSMHA is thrilled to be hosting our 10th series of Fall tune up tourneys for the upcoming season! These tournaments will be for representative teams classified "A" to "AE 1". It will be a great measuring stick to see how your team stacks up against very good competition early in the season . Each age group will be 8 team tourneys running 2 divisions of 4 teams. Teams will play a 3 game round robin on the Saturday at the designated arena. The top two point teams from each division will advance to the semi-finals on Sunday morning at the designated arena . The winners of the semis will play for the championship early Sunday afternoon. Teams not advancing to Sundays' playoffs will receive participation awards. Semi-finalists, Finalists &

Champions will receive individual awards. Our Novice & Tyke Tourneys this season will be 2 day events hosting 8 teams guaranteeing 4 games/team. The Saturday will be the round robin with 2 divisions of 4 teams. Each team will play the other 3 teams in their division on a point system. At the end of the round robin teams will be ranked from 1st to 4th in each division. Starting at 8 am on the Sunday morn the two 4th place teams will play for the "D" championship. At 9:15 am the two 3rd place teams will play for the "C" Championship. At 10:30 am the two 2nd place teams will play for the "B" championship. At 11:45 the two first place teams will play for the "A" championship. NOTE! All players in the Novice & Tyke divisions will receive an award! Sunday Tyke times will be 10 am, 11:15am, 12:30pm & 1:45pm.

The Fall Classic Entry Fee for Tyke, Novice, Atom & Peewee is \$725.00 GATE INCLUDED and for Bantam & Midget \$775.00 GATE INCLUDED. Come to Haliburton County this fall to participate in our fun hockey tournaments and enjoy the scenery of one of the most beautiful places in Canada!

FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS

Team Officials will be required to register their team with approved OMHA roster sheets at least one hour prior to the teams' first game at the designated arena. NOTE! Teams without approved rosters will not be allowed to participate. Teams participating who are NOT in the OMHA must have approved team roster sheets from their league and TRAVEL PERMITS from their league.

Please complete the entry form and submit the entry fee promptly (cheques must be payable to the Highland Storm Minor Hockey Association, please mark on cheque for which tournament it is to be applied). For all teams entering the Silver Stick AE Regionals, the registration deadline is October 1st 2016 and you will be notified by October 15/16 on eligibility. As these tournaments are regionals, the teams from the eastern zone of the OMHA should have preference.
